Introduction

Snowball Analytics, a French company (SIRET 914 331 640 00013) having its registered office LE FORUM 27 RUE MAURICE FLANDIN 69444 LYON CEDEX 3 (hereinafter "Company" or "Us" or "We") operates the website, https://snowball-analytics.com/ (the "Service").

As part of its activities and in accordance with the regulations applicable in France and in Europe, particularly the EU General Data Protection Regulation, Snowball Analytics is committed to ensuring the protection, confidentiality and security of the personal data of its users, customers, prospects and suppliers, as well as to respecting their privacy.

This Privacy Policy describes Our policies and procedures on the collection, use, and disclosure of personal data when you use our Service. By using the Service, You agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree to this collection and use of information in full and without modification, then you may not access, view, use, or register for any portion of the Services.

Our Service is not intended for minors unless authorised by their legal representatives.

The Privacy Policy may be subject to changes. It is specified that Snowball Analytics may amend the Privacy Policy at any time, including to adapt it to current legislation. Users are made aware of these modifications simply through their publication online. We recommend that you regularly check the current version available.

Information Collection And Use

We collect several different types of information for various purposes to provide and improve our Service to you. The types of data we collect are listed below.

Personal Data

Access to Our Service granted after registering an account, for that purpose You provide Us email address and name of account. Once you register and sign in to our Service, you are not anonymous to us.

If you want to buy a subscription, we may need your first name, last name and postal address.

To provide You analytics and other information about your investing results You provide Us your Portfolio Data (can include transactions).

We may use your Personal Data to contact you with newsletters, marketing or promotional materials and other information that may be of interest to you. You may opt out of receiving any, or all, of these communications from us by following the unsubscribe link or instructions provided in any email we send.

We use Transport Layer Security (TLS) encryption technology in order to protect certain information that you submit to us. This technology protects you from having your information intercepted by anyone while it is being transmitted to Snowball Analytics or payment processor.

Usage Data

To make our Service better we may also collect information how the Service is accessed and used ("Usage Data"). This Usage Data may including information, but not limited to, such as your computer's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

Use of Your Personal Data

We may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

- To provide and maintain our Service.

Where is your personal data stored?

Your personal data is stored inside the European Union, either in our databases or in those of our service providers.

In some cases, and mainly for technical reasons, data may be stored on servers located outside the European Union.

Data transfers outside the EU

Due in particular to the international dimension of Snowball Analytics, some of our partners are located outside the European Union. The data collected may therefore be transferred to countries outside the European Union which have different personal data protection legislation from those inside the European Union.

In this case, Snowball Analytics implements the means to ensure the security and confidentiality of such data and ensures that the transfer meets the legal framework: the transfer to a country ensuring a sufficient level of protection, signature of contractual clauses issued by the European Commission, or any other regulatory or contractual means to ensure a sufficient level of protection.

Snowball Analytics strictly requires its partners to only use your personal data to manage or provide the services requested, and also asks its partners to always act in compliance with the applicable laws on personal data protection and pay particular attention to the confidentiality of such data.

Retention of Data

We will retain your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

We will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis purposes. Usage Data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of our Service, or we are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

Business Transactions

If the Company is involved in a merger, acquisition or asset sale, Your Personal Data may be transferred. We will provide notice before Your Personal Data is transferred and becomes subject to a different Privacy Policy.

Law enforcement

Under certain circumstances, the Company may be required to disclose Your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g. a court or a government agency).

Other legal requirements

- Protect and defend the rights or property of the Company

WHAT IS A COOKIE AND LOCAL STORAGE OBJECT?

Definition

Cookies and other similar technologies such as local storage objects, local shared objects, flash cookies or pixels, are small files that web servers send to your computer to store and retrieve information about your visits, as well as to provide proper functioning of the site. Detailed information on cookies used on this website

Information about proprietary and strictly necessary cookies:

Certain cookies (and other similar technologies) are exempt from the consent requirement under French data protection law, namely cookies (and other similar technologies) whose sole purpose is to enable or facilitate electronic communications or that are **strictly necessary** for the provision of an online communication service as expressly requested by the user. We use localStorage object to store authentication data, persistent user interface customization data, necessary user data. These functional/technical localStorage object is necessary to display the website correctly, and to guarantee the website's correct functioning. With these, we can, for example, control traffic and data communication, identify you during the session, give you access to sections with restricted access, and use security elements during your navigation.
